The Participating Teams Obligations

Players Qualifications

- Each team competing has to register 8 players and after they are sent to the SATUC team they cannot be changed
- The list must contain each player's name, his shirt number, his birthdate and a valid passport number.
- The football associations have to send the necessary documents to SATUC to make the players and managers cards.
- The participating team is to consist of 10 individuals, 8 players and 2 administrators. Any delegations with more than 10 individuals have to afford the extra individuals.

REGULATIONS

The following requirements have to be met in a player:

- · He must need this opportunity
- He must be of the same nationality as the country he is representing.
- His name must match the name on his valid passport.
- He must have no diseases and medical reports confirming his status should be sent.
- If a player violates one of these conditions represented his country in a match, he will be punished by the following:
- His team would be immediately eliminated.
- The organizing committee can add further penalties
- A SATUC committee will inspect the player's passport and documents and if any mismatch or misleading information is found concerning a player, he will not be allowed to participate in the tournament and his national team will have to pay for the tickets and/or any further expenses.



The SATUC World Cup System and the Draw -Matches Game rules

The SATUC World Cup matches are played according to the rules of the SATUC football constitution (5-A-Side) and doesn't conflict with the law of the game (5-A-Side law). (The tournament will be played on natural grass). CHARITY REGISTRATION NO.

REGULATIONS

The teams will arrive on 13/4/2020 and a Match will be held the following day.

The tournament is held for four days and matches are played according to the following schedule:

Day 1: First 2 matches of the group stage.

Day 2: Third match of the group stage and the Quarter Finals.

Day 3: Semi-Finals and 3rd Place Match.

Day 4: Final.

REGULATIONS

Starting players

- The substitution is available during the whole match and the substituted player can play again.
- The goalkeeper is allowed to be substituted with any
 of the subs but the referee must be informed and the
 substituted player must wear the keeper outfit.
- Every team consists of 5 players inside the field including the goalkeeper and 3 players as subs.
- There should be at least 4 players at the beginning of the match and that the match can be played with 3 players if the number of players becomes less than 3 for injury or for red card penalty the referee can end the match and report to the organizing committee
- During the match, the subs and the managers should remain on their seats only the coach is allowed to stand in the technical area to give orders. All the subs should remain in their seats till they are called for substitution.

REGULATIONS

Finals organization

- Number of participating teams is 16 team divided into 4 groups
- The hosting country is put on the top of the first group and the titleholder is put on the top of the second group. If the hosting country is the team that was the titleholder, therefore, the second-place winner will be put on top of the second grouping the matches are held according to the following
- The matches are held according to the one round league system to determine the first and second places within every group
- 8 teams proceed to the quarter-finals and they play each other based on knock out system and the 4 teams proceed to semi-finals
- The 4 teams meet in semi-finals and the teams that lose play for third and fourth positions and the winners play for first and second positions to determine the champion.

Points system

The points are given in the matches played according to league system affording the following:

3 points for winning, 1 for a draw and zero points for losing

The team's position is determined according to the points awarded to the team

REGULATIONS

The draw situations

If tow or more teams in a single group finish the group stage with the same number of points, the team which qualify is determined based on:

The team with more goals, advances to the next round. If the teams have the same amount of goals, the team with most goals scored in the full time of the match advances.

If the teams are still tied, the results of the head to head matches are taken into consideration.

If the teams are still tied, the team with the least number of yellow and red cards advances.

If the teams are still tied, a random draw is held.

REGULATIONS

Match Conditions

- Tournament matches are held on outdoor natural grass fields from morning to night.
- These football fields must also meet international association standards. (40x20 m)
- SATUC and the football association of the country where the tournament is held are responsible for securing the stadiums from the inside and outside before, through and after the game.
- Tools and equipment of each match must meet the standards of the international association.
- The teams are entitled to have a training session at the stadium where the tournament will be held a day before the tournament begins.
- Teams are entitled to warm up before the match.
- Smoking is not permitted in the stadium or around the kids.
- The only ads allowed in the stadium are those of SATUC and what SATUC approves of. Also, the stadium is at the disposal of SATUC.

ZEGULATIONS

Match Duration

Match duration is 30 minutes divided into two halves, each half is 15 minutes with a 3-minute break between the two halves. The teams switch sides during the break. (Group Stage Matches) Match duration is 40 minutes divided into two halves, each half is 20 minutes with a 5-minute break between the two halves. (Quarter-Finals till the Final)The referee tosses a coin to decide which team starts the match with the ball. If a match can't be held due to urgent reasons (power cut-off or weather conditions), the match is delayed 24 hours and if the same reasons continue, the organizing committee is to take further action. In the knockout stages, if any match ends with a draw, a best out of five penalty shootout takes place to determine the winner. In the semi-finals and finals, in case of a draw, an extra ten minutes is played on two halves where each half is five minutes. If the teams are still tied, a penalty shootout takes place to determine the winner.

REGULATIONS

Objections and Appealing

Each team has the right to object on a match or a certain call according to the following:

The objection must be written and handed to the fourth official or one of the organizing committee members within two hours of the match. The objection must be signed by the president of the delegation.

The objection is then transferred to the discipline committee where it is viewed and a decision must be taken by the committee before the objection side next match.

During the match, no objections should be presented towards the referee directly.

Each team has the right to appeal any decision made by the discipline committee according to the following: The appealing is transferred to the organizing committee which in turn sends it to the appealing committee.

The appealing order must contain a detailed report about the decision made by the discipline committee. The appealing committee must view the order directly after receiving it.

REGULATION

General rules and instructions

- The federations and foundations participating must commit to the rules and instructions concerning the sports equipment such that it is not allowed to print or publish any political, religious or commercial slogan on the equipment including the team handbags and medical bags. Further action may be taken by the organising committee in this case.
- During the matches, all the equipment (outfit bags medical equipment) have to be checked and approved by SATUC.
- The balls used in matches have to be chosen by SATUC to make sure it matches the international federation standards.
